

<p>Narration: Today I will be teaching you the simplest way to tie a tie, all you have to do is follow these easy steps and you will have the perfect tie for any occasion.</p> <p>Music: NONE</p>	<p>*TITLE SLIDE*</p>
<p>Narration: The first step is to find a tie that you like</p> <p>Music None</p>	<p>*Still image of Tie*</p>
<p>Narration: Next you want to position the tie around your neck and position it so that the skinnier side is over your left shoulder and the thicker side is over your right shoulder</p> <p>Music: None</p>	<p>*Image of Tie*</p>
<p>Narration: You want to position the tie so that the part that is around you left should is approximately half of the length of the part that is around your right shoulder</p>	<p>*Video showing the tie in that position*</p>

<p>Narration: Next we will take the right side of the tie and overlap it over the left side</p>	<p>*Video showing how to position the tie”</p>
<p>Narration: Once the right side is over the left, we will then bring that side around the back and through the little loop we have created using the two sides of the tie</p>	<p>*Video showing this step*</p>
<p>Narration: Once the thicker side is back to the front we will once again take that side but this time wrap it around that sort of knot that we have just created</p>	<p>*Video showing this*</p>
<p>Narration: Loop the thick part around the knot once and bring it back to its original position, once it is at that position you will see that we have created a knot</p>	<p>*Video showing this step*</p>

<p>Narration: Now taking the thick part, bring it around the back and feed it through the knot that we have just created and pull it through, but make sure not to do it too tight just yet</p>	<p>*Video showing this part*</p>
<p>Narration: Once you have the thick part through, pull it and use your other hand to form the knot of the tie into a triangular shape</p>	<p>*Video showing this part*</p>
<p>Narration: Once you have happy with the shape hold the knot gently with one hand and the back, thinner part, with the other and push the knot up.</p>	<p>*Video showing this part</p>
<p>Narration: And there you go you have just tied a tie. Also always remember that your tie should sit right above your belt, so if your tie is too short or too long restart and play around with the lengths of both sides until you get it right, I hope you enjoyed!</p>	<p>*Video showing this part*</p>
